BACHELOR OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (B.R.E.) PROGRAMS

» Biblical Studies Program [Concentrations]

Counseling will equip you with the knowledge, skills and passion to best understand and help people in need. A strong Christian framework encompasses every aspect of the program in order for students to acquire a basic knowledge of psychology and counseling from a biblical perspective. Biblical education, research, critical thinking, supervised internships and mentoring help prepare students for graduate study and full-time employment.

Christian Ministries is ideal if you plan to pursue graduate study or if you are transferring a significant number of credit hours from other colleges. The curriculum allows learners to combine courses from several different concentrations to create their own flexible degree program.

International Ministries prepares you to serve globally in Christian missions agencies with cultural relevance and a biblical worldview. The program provides graduates with ministry and professional training for careers in areas such as missions, international relations, relief agency assistance, language translation, church planting, discipleship and human services.

***Pastoral Studies** prepares graduates for the various duties of pastoral oversight in the local church. Evangelism, missions, administration, worship, preaching and counseling skills are taught throughout the curriculum. Since 1900, practical application of biblical teaching has been the heart of our pastoral program. Graduates are prepared to teach God's Word in a way that is doctrinally sound and applicable to life situations. *Only men are eligible for the Pastoral Studies concentration at Davis College.

Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL) is the ideal concentration if you have a heart for missions but aren't sure where to begin. Doors are open all over the world for ESL (English as a Second Language) teachers; even countries that are closed otherwise to the gospel welcome ESL teachers with open arms. Graduates from TESL who meet certain requirements have options to pursue a master's degree in teaching at universities in New York and South Carolina. Youth Ministries is designed to prepare you with insight into adolescent dynamics. Students will receive collegiate coursework, individual mentoring designed to foster personal formation, and professional field experiences intended to establish ministry competency.

» Music/Worship Leader Program

The Music/Worship Leader program will prepare you for a career in ministry such as Worship Leader, Creative Arts Administrator, Worship Pastor, Music Director or Drama Coach. College chapels and community outreach events give students opportunities to use their creative abilities at Davis while learning the fundamentals of the music/worship leader profession.

» Organizational Leadership Program

The Organizational Leadership program will develop your understanding of Christian leadership and ethics. The concentration also enhances the competencies and skills in management, business, communication, interpersonal relationships, problem-solving, change implementation, and multicultural sensitivities. The program equips leaders to serve in churches, para-church organizations and societal organizations at large. This program fills a void in leadership training and management in any and all organizations that wish to make a difference in their roles, markets and contributions.

ASSOCIATE'S OF APPLIED SCIENCE (A.A.S.) DEGREE PROGRAMS

The A.A.S. degree in Bible and theology is a 65-hour, two-year program with a 26-hour Bible and Theology major. It is ideal if you want a biblical degree as a foundation for upper division study in any other field or for students who want an associate's degree to complement their lay leadership in the local church. The program articulates well with the B.R.E. degree programs for students who wish to continue their education at Davis after completing their A.A.S.

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***ASSOCIATE'S OF APPLIED SCIENCE IN EARLY CHILDHOD EDUCATION ADMINISTRATION**

The A.A.S. in Early Childhood Education Administration will prepare you to interact with and teach young children in a variety of settings. The program teaches students to operate a licensed day care or own their own home-based business providing professional child care services. Graduates may also work in child care settings in churches, ministries, or human service agencies. The program provides experiential training, preparation for management careers, and observation hours in professional child care programs.

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CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

» One-Year Bible Certificate*

The One-Year Bible Certificate is a 31-hour, two-semester program that will provide you with a solid foundation of Bible knowledge. The program is designed for smooth articulation into the AAS degree and the BRE degree. The Bible Certificate Program can be completed in two full-time semesters or through part-time study.

» One-Year Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL) Certificate*

The One-Year Certificate in Teaching English as a Second Language is a 24-hour, two-semester program that provides the specialized courses that are part of the BRE degree program concentration in TESL. The one-year TESL certificate program is especially attractive if you already possess a bachelor's degree or equivalent and want to engage in a concentrated program of study in TESL.

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ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

Davis College has a "Four Plus One" Articulation Agreement allowing students to complete their Bachelor's at Davis and receive a Master of Science in Education degree (MS Ed) to teach either Early Childhood N-3 or Elementary K-6 at an affiliated university. This arrangement provides graduates with teacher certification that is reciprocal in 48 states including New York, Pennsylvania and Florida.
